your own design because it is going to be hard to stop at just one neckpiece. Full color instructions with diagrams and extra templates are included with the class fee. \$60




Autumn Splendor with Susan Eisemann Advanced Sunday, November 2nd 10-4pm

Nature doesn't dictate the colors of our caterpillars. With five colors of vines and too many seed bead colors to count just try to limit yourself. \$35




Celestial Bracelet with Barb Intermediate/Exp. with Ricks Loom Sunday, November 16th 10:30-2:30pm

Cha Cha Class Bundle with Susan Eisemann

Intermediate - Students must be able to RAW without assistance.



Use them alone on a ribbon or

incorporate them into your strung necklace or bracelet. Don't forget about earrings! Learn a beading technique using a very unconventional method with double line & no knots.



Cha Cha 1: 10-12:30pm

The basic square bead. Can be used as a component in your strung necklace or bracelet work. Make a few in different colors and string them all on leather cording or place sections of chain between the beads. \$30

Cha Cha 2: 1-4pm

The round bead. This version works up fast and requires minimal reinforcement. Make a necklace or bracelet of all round beads or string on leather cording. \$35





Crimping 101 with Barb Beginner Wednesday, September 17th or Friday, October 24th 10:30-12pm or 6:30-8pm

Graduate from an elastic bracelet to a

long-lasting, secure piece of jewelry. You'll design two bracelets and learn to use the crimping plier. \$25 (includes partial kit)

Earring Workshop *Beginner*

Wednesday, September 10th or Friday. October 17th 10:30-11:30am or 6-7pm

A great, quick course to introduce jewelry pliers and to learn how to make loops and link them together. This skill is used in a variety of beading applications. In this class,



your loops will make a pair of dangle earrings for you to wear home! \$15 (Includes supplies).



Flat Peyote Bracelet with Beainner

Tuesday, September 23rd 10:30-1pm or 6:30-9pm

Always in demand, learn the basic, but essential, off-loom weaving stitch. Create a

flat strip that can later be completed as a bracelet. You will work with large beads (8/0 size) to easily allow you to understand how to apply this technique. \$30

Garden of Versailles with Susan Eisemann Advanced Sunday, September 28th 10-3pm

A blooming garden of Swarovski crystal flowers is dotted with pearls to complete

this spectacular, blooming garden. Double-wide cuff bracelet is encompassed with delicas to outline the multi-rows of flowers. Full set of color instructions included with class fee. \$60



Garden Path with Susan Eisemann Advanced

Sunday, October 5th 10-4pm

The beaded path crisscrosses many times until it arrives at the main element of the necklace. Basic bezzeling

technique will be taught so you can select a main focal bead it may be your favorite button, cabochon, druzy, rivoli, or glass bead; the possibilities are endless. Full color instructions will be included with class fee. This may be the time for you to get the great clasp that you had your eye on. \$70

Herringbone Pathway Bracelet with Susan Magielnicki Intermediate (working herringbone stitch skills)

Sunday, August 17th 1-4pm, Friday, September 26th 6:30-9:30pm, Sunday, November 9th 1-4pm, or Wednesday, November 19th 10:30-1:30pm

Beautiful herringbone stitch bracelet made with Super Duo two-hole beads. Can be made with one solid color bead or random multi-colored beads of your choice. \$35



Leather, Chain, and Glitz with Susan Magielnicki All Levels

Wednesday, October 1st 10:30-12:30pm Bracelet made with rolo chain, cup chain and leather cord. Learn the process of weaving leather cording through the chain and cup chain. The bracelet is expandable for various

size wrists. It can also be made without the cup chain for a more unisex version. \$25

Leather Eyelet Wrap with Barb Sunday, September 21st 10:30-1:30pm

A new twist to the popular wrap bracelet. We will play with rivets and eyelets to enable us to weave 2-hole pyramid beads but once you know the



technique it will be fun to see your creative juices flow. \$35



Night Knotters with Donna All Levels Thursday, October 16th 6:30-9:30pm Learn to string and professionally knot a necklace. This is the preferred method for semi-precious natural beads for weight distribution and security. Instruction

includes attaching a clasp using French wire. \$40

The Perfect Ending with Barb Advanced beginner (basic peyote skills required)

Friday, August 22nd 10:30-2:30pm or 6-10pm or Sunday, November 23rd 10:30-

...and the beads lived happily ever after. The perfect clasp is sometimes impossible to find

so why not make your own? We will use basic Peyote techniques to form a toggle that can perform double duty. If placed in the back as a utility clasp or in the front as a focal. \$45

or Swarovski pearls. Students must be

Beginner, weaving experience helpful.

Right-Angle Weave (R.A.W.) at its most basic level is simply beautiful in this cuff. Learn this challenging but versatile stitch that will open



doors to many creative adventures. We will use 4mm Swarovski crystals and pearls to create a cuff that is both sparkly and soft. \$45
