Basic Loom with Barb Beginner Tuesday, June 30th; Sunday, July 19th; or Friday, August 21st 10:30-2:30pm

Learn all the essentials of looming in this workshop, from wrapping the warp threads to knotting off. The new loom

simplifies the process and makes it so much fun! As a bonus, you'll make a reversible bracelet. \$45

Why should quilters and needle workers have all the fun? Learn the ins and outs of charts by following a

Bodacious Bangle with Kathy Koppinger *Advanced* Beginner/Intermediate Sunday, July 26th 10-3pm

This bracelet is constructed with a base of tubular pevote with a 3-

dimensional netting layer on top. This layer is embellished with 3mm bicone crystals. It can be done with another row of netting which will allow 3 rows of crystals. If the base is made narrower, the appearance of the bracelet is changed. \$55



Bubbles Necklace with Barb Advanced beginner

This impactful statement necklace is deceptive. Let's put to use the first skills

most of us learned and construct a piece that will put a smile on your face every time you wear it. Prerequisite: proficient crimping and basic loop



Caterpillar on a Vine with Barb All levels; experience with seed beads Wednesday, May 20th 10:30-1:30pm or 6:30-9:30pm

Nature doesn't dictate the colors of our caterpillars. With five colors of vines

and too many seed bead colors to count just try to limit yourself. \$35

Create this inspired bracelet using a

basic Chevron chain stitch that forms a three-row flat piece that will be sewn into a three-sided tubular structure. It will then be curved into a rounded shape, embellished, and the ends finishing with a closure. \$35

Flat Peyote Bracelet with Barb Beginner

Thursday, July 9th 10:30-1pm or 6:30-9pm

Always in demand, learn the basic, but essential, off-loom weaving stitch.

Create a flat strip that can later be completed as a bracelet. You will work with large beads (8/0 size) to easily allow you to understand how to apply this technique. \$30



Herringbone Pathway Bracelet with Susan Magielnicki

Intermediate (working herringbone stitch skills)

Thursday, July 23rd 10:30-1:30pm; Tuesday, July 28th 6:30-9:30pm

Beautiful herringbone stitch bracelet made with Super Duo two-hole beads. Can be made with

one solid color bead or random multi-colored beads of your choice. \$35

Insinuation Cuff with Kathy Koppinger *Advanced Beginner* **Sunday, August 9**th **12-3pm**

This cuff bracelet is done in circular herringbone. Several sizes of beads in a contrasting color are inserted



to provide interest. Round beads are added on each edge to add a bit of contrast, or add crystals instead to enhance the bling factor. This bracelet is a bangle with no clasp but could easily be adapted to use a clasp. \$35



Lacy Cuff Bracelet with Dorothy Carretta

Beginner/ Intermediate

Wednesday, July 1st and July 8th 10:30-12:30pm

This striking bracelet is constructed with a variation on the chevron chain technique. It can be made with size 11 or 08 beads which will create a textured lattice structure which can then be embellished with an accent bead. Closures will be determined by the width of the structure. \$45



Lunar Lights Necklace with Susan Eisemann *Advanced* Sunday, June 14th 10-4pm

The Lunar Light of this necklace can be pearls or natural stone, two completely different looks. The basic stitch is RAW technique. Added

stitching to the base and of course crystal enhancements then add the finishing glow of light. \$70

Mosaic Pendants with Nancy Frank *All levels*

Friday, July 10th 11-1pm or Sunday, August 16th 10-12pm

Create mosaic pendants using your imagination and creativity. Each pendant will be unique and original. The sky is the limit! \$25



Mosaics and Beads Perfect Together with Nancy Frank All levels Friday, July 24th 11-3pm or Sunday, August 23rd 12-4pm

This workshop features an introduction to mosaics using beads and favorite objects to be adhered to a small substrate known as ATC (Artist Trading Card). Create to

Palace Garden Hydrangea necklace and earrings, either way it is an eye catcher. \$60




Scroll Slide with Barb *Advanced Beginner* Wednesday, July 15th 10:30-1:30pm or 6:30-9:30pm

A wrap bracelet using stringing wire and a button closure. Make this bracelet with superduos, pavers, or any two-hole You can make a triple, double or single wrap. \$35



Wired Frame Earring with Barb Friday, June 26th 6:30-8:30pm; Wednesday, July 29th 10:30-12:30pm; or Friday, August 28th 6:30-8:30 or 10:30-12:30pm

The hardest part of making these striking earrings is picking the shape of the frame
