### Basic Loom with Barb

*Beginner*

Sunday, October 15<sup>th</sup> 10-2pm

Learn all the essentials of looming in this workshop, from wrapping the warp threads to knotting off. The new loom simplifies the process and makes it so much fun! As a bonus, you'll make a reversible bracelet. \$45



### Crimping 101 with Barb

*Beginner*

Friday, September 22<sup>nd</sup>  
10:30-12pm or 6:30-8pm

Graduate from an elastic bracelet to a long-lasting, secure piece of jewelry. You'll design two bracelets and learn to use the two-step crimping plier. \$25 (includes partial kit)

### Earring Workshop

*Beginner*

Friday, September 15<sup>th</sup> 10:30-11:30am  
or 6-7pm

A great, quick course to introduce jewelry pliers and to learn how to make loops and link them together. This skill is used in a variety of beading applications. In this class, your loops will make a pair of dangle earrings for you to wear home! \$15 (Includes supplies).



### Fan Dangle with Dorothy Carretta

*Beginner, some beading experience helpful*

Have fun making Fancy or Everyday earrings with Bugle beads, Super Duos, Seed beads and Crystals. \$35

### Flat Peyote Bracelet with Barb

*Beginner*

Friday, September 29<sup>th</sup> 10:30-1pm

Always in demand, learn the basic, but essential, off-loom weaving stitch. Create a flat strip that can later be completed as a bracelet. You will work with large (8/0 size) beads to easily allow you to learn and apply this technique. \$30



### Lacy Cuff Bracelet with Dorothy Carretta

*Beginner/ Intermediate*

Saturday, September 23<sup>rd</sup> 11-2pm

This striking bracelet is constructed with a variation on the chevron chain technique. It can be made with size 11/0 or 8/0 beads which will create a textured lattice structure which can then be embellished with an accent bead. Closures will be determined by the width of the bracelet structure. \$35

### Ombracelet with Barb *Off-loom experience helpful*

Friday, October 27<sup>th</sup> 10:30-1:30pm  
or 6:30-9:30pm

Gentle tone graduations flow around your wrist nestling crystals. The most difficult part of making this bracelet will be which color palette will be first (it won't be your last!) \$35



### Open "Weave" Bracelet with Dorothy Carretta

*Beginner, some beading experience*

Friday, October 6<sup>th</sup> 11-2pm

This comfortable bracelet, using super duos in a modified peyote stitch, to create the structure, gives an impression of being woven. \$35

### Ruffled Peyote Bezel with Barb

*Beginner*

Friday, November 3<sup>rd</sup> 6-9:30pm

This is cabochon bezeling 101. If you have ever been curious how to do this technique... now is your chance! We'll take it step by step and build it layer by layer. \$40



### Star Fishin' Bracelet with Susan Eisemann

*Intermediate*

Sunday, September 17<sup>th</sup> 10-3pm

People will almost sprain your arm trying to get a glimpse at this stunner of a bracelet. What is better than a Rivoli surrounded by seed beads and rose montees? The companion piece to the Star Fishin' pendant or worn with your other fashion pieces, will be sure to draw attention. \$60



**Studded Cuff with Barb** *All levels*  
**Friday, October 6<sup>th</sup> 6-8:30pm**  
 Let's make metal bend to our will. We'll cut, file, rivet, add texture and potentially patina to transform a simple sheet of copper. \$30



**Wired Frame Earring with Barb**  
*All levels, E/R experience helpful*  
**Friday, November 17<sup>th</sup> 10:30-12:30pm or 6:30-8:30pm**

The hardest part of making these striking earrings is picking the shape of the frame (and there are only three)!

Don't worry, there's no rule saying you can't make the other shape later. \$25
